



## Product Information Sheet Carcassing C24 Treated Timber

Our treated C24 KD Regularised Carcassing Timber is a structural timber, used for stud walls, roof & floor joists, and structural joinery. C24 grade has fewer defects and knots than C16, so is stronger with a higher point load.

C24 is machined to have rounded edges, smooth faces and sides, for a more uniformed piece of timber. It is also kiln dried to reduce moisture content and increase the strength and stability, and is pressure treated with preservatives to increase resistance to rotting.

### Which is better C16 or C24 timber?

Although C24 timber is of higher quality than C16, offering more strength overall, the best timber for your project depends on what it's being used for. Whilst C24 is recommended for heavy load bearing carcassing, it can be more expensive, so C16 may be better for joists and decking in some domestic properties.

Both C16 and C24 timber are types of kiln-dried softwood, which are graded to show their strength and quality. The higher the number, the stronger the wood. C24 timber offers high strength and premium quality. C16 may have more defects and is slightly less strong, but it's still a durable wood for construction.

### Quality

C24 timber is a premium grade of timber that is stronger and more resilient than C16 timber. It is imported from areas with a slower growth rate, which results in a tighter grain and more growth rings. The more growth rings a piece of wood has, the denser and more durable it is.

### C24 Carcassing Uses

C24 timber is suitable for both indoor and outdoor use, and is often used for floor joists, roof joists, and timber framing. It is also a popular choice for outdoor landscaping projects because it is resistant to moisture.

### C24 Carcassing Appearance

C24 timber is typically defect-free and has a better appearance than C16 timber, making it a good choice for visible applications. It can be stained or painted to match your project.
